

On-Demand File Submission

Files for DocuColor submission should be provided in composite PDF format, including bleeds. Bleeds should be set at 1/8" bigger than your actual page size, please see example below. No crop marks should be included. All color images should be in CMYK, at least 300 dpi resolution, and not use any OPI settings. Bitmap images should be at least 1200 dpi. All fonts should be embedded or converted to outlines. In order to create the best possible PDF for printing, we recommend creating a postscript file of your document first and then using Acrobat distiller to create the PDF. To create a compatible PDF from Quark, you will need to save each page as an EPS including images and bleeds and then distill using Acrobat Distiller. To create a compatible PDF from InDesign, you can create the PDF directly, choosing the appropriate distiller setting or create EPS pages including images and bleeds and then distill using Acrobat Distiller. The Imperial distiller job option is available on request to use with Acrobat distiller.
